



## *Installing and understanding the 30 and 50-amp RV Electric Service*



The RV owner should know the difference between the 30 and the 50-amp RV service also the other 30 and 50-amp Services that are used in everyday applications but could be harmful to the RV. Most importantly everyone should know how to test a receptacle **BEFORE** plugging in the first time.

If you would like to install a receptacle for your RV make sure you understand basic wiring. It is not that hard as long as you follow the rules. **Never work on electric panels without turning off the MAIN breaker.** Even with the MAIN breaker turned off there is juice in the main service box on the two HOT feeds coming in from the street.

**Be careful ELECTRICITY can kill.**
