

# **HEARTLAND RV FEATURE - EXPLAINED**

## **Welcome Back Light**

## Abstract

Beginning with the 2011 model year, some Heartland 5<sup>th</sup> wheels (primarily Landmark and Bighorn) include a feature called the "Welcome Back Light". This article explains the operation of this feature.

## <u>Light</u>

The light that can be controlled by this feature is the light on the ceiling, nearest to the entrance door. This light is referred to as the "Aisle Light".

<u>Switch</u>

In early versions of this feature, there was a visible switch in the door jamb area. More recent iterations of this feature utilize a magnetic switch built into the door. This switch is not visible.

#### How it works

When the exterior entrance door (not the screen door) is opened and the Aisle Light switch is in the OFF position, the Welcome Back Light feature turns the Aisle Light ON. The light stays on for approximately 1 minute, then dims out to an OFF state.

#### Over-ride

You may operate the Aisle Light manually as normal by using the Aisle Light switch inside the coach. Note however, if the Aisle Light is switched to the ON position, the Welcome Back Light feature will be disabled, as the light will already be ON.
